Lesson Times and Location:

Weekly lessons are recommended, with a length of time based on the student's age and level. Lessons take place at my home studio in Burbank, California or at Glendale Adventist Academy.

Students are required to purchase lesson materials, reeds and supplies (as required) and bring to each lesson. Instruction focuses on developing breathing, embouchure, fingering, rhythmic and articulation skills as well as developing good practicing habits.
